

## **Main Activities Plan for FY2022**

### Competitions, training camps, and sports promotion and independent activities

• In addition to implementing sports competitions, the facility will also provide opportunities for Tokyo residents to gain familiarity with hockey such as classes.

#### • Hockey Japan League (HJL)

Major hockey competitions such as the WMH Masters Hockey World Cup 2022 Tokyo as well as hockey and lacrosse international exchange matches and domestic major competitions and league games will be held. (Throughout the year)

#### • Hockey Dream Camp

With hockey Olympians as teachers, these classes will express the fun of hockey to participants. (Scheduled for July, January, and March.)



## Usage for a variety of sports

• The facility will provide a space Tokyo residents can use for a variety of different sports such as soccer, lacrosse, and American football.

#### Touch Rugby experience event and Session

Through touch rugby experience event, the facility will provide opportunities to gain familiarity with this recreational activity. (Scheduled for July and August.)

#### • Multipurpose court (new addition) usage for sports such as futsal

A new multipurpose court added to the side of the main pitch will be used for sports such as mini hockey and futsal. (Throughout the year)



#### **Coordination with surrounding facilities and area residents**

• A variety of events will be held to elevate the appeal of the surrounding area as a whole, including the Oi Hockey Stadium, in coordination with park facilities, local districts, and other surroundings.

### **Olymplementation of events in coordination with various organisations**

Events will be implemented which allow participants to experience a variety of different activities at Oi Hockey Stadium, bringing excitement to the local area. (June)
