## Facility overview

- Location: 1-11-1 Ariake, Koto-ku, Tokyo
- Total floor area: Approx. 47,200m<sup>2</sup> (5 floors above ground)
- Spectator stand: Approx. 15,000 seats (incl. temporary seats)
- Main facilities: Main Arena, Sub Arena, Changing rooms etc.
- Completion date: Dec. 2019
- Sports: Olympic/ Volleyball  
Paralympic/ Wheelchair Basketball
- Reopening: Schedule to reopen in Aug. 2022
- Facility operator: Tokyo Ariake Arena (concession operator)

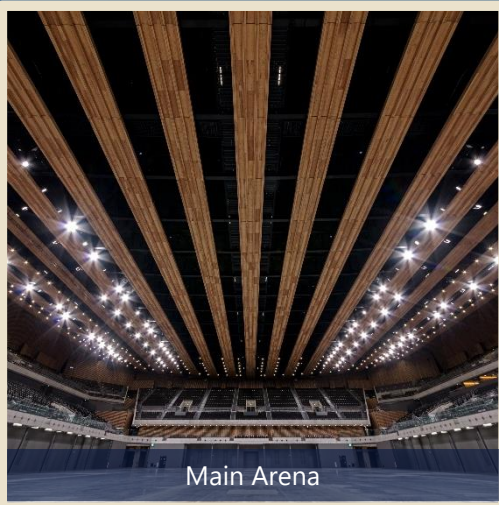

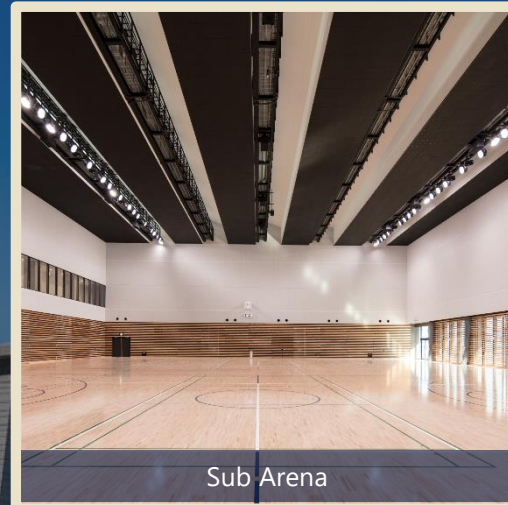
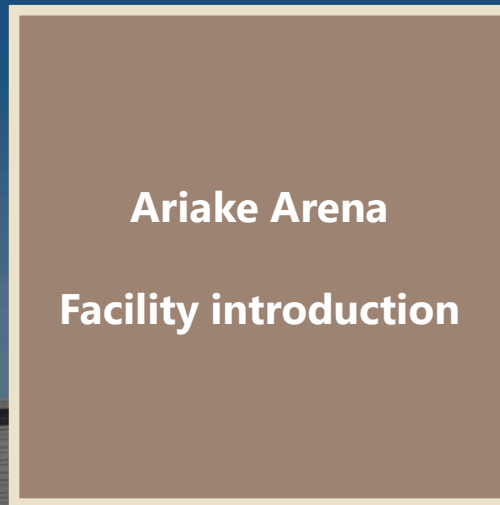
## Facility management concept

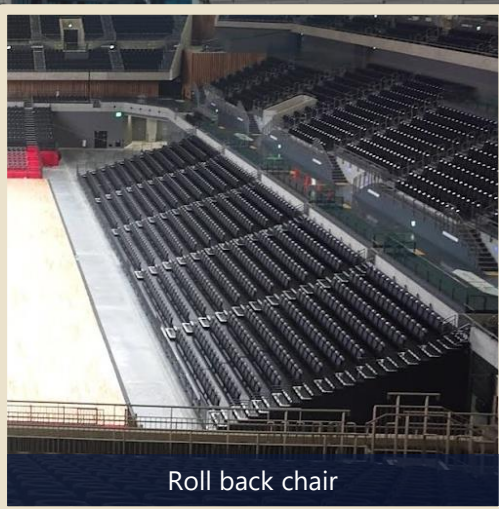




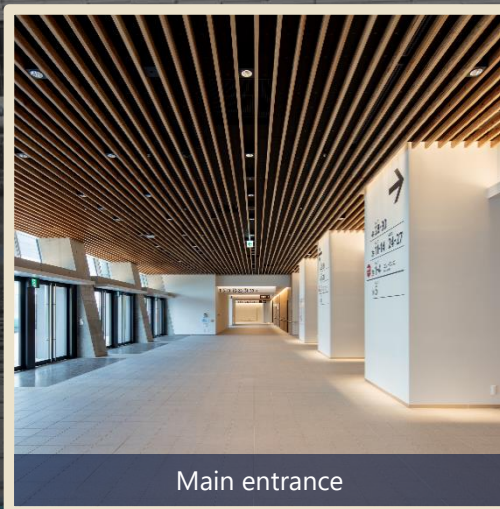

# Main Initiatives for Concession Operators in FY2022

## Diverse facility usage

- The facility will be utilised for a wide range of activities such as usage by top athletes, artists, and Tokyo residents.

### ◎ Attracting and hosting of large-scale sports competitions

To carry on the legacy of the Tokyo 2020 Games, attract international sports competitions and other large-scale events for athletes inside and outside of Japan to the facility.

### ◎ Providing an entertainment venue

The facility will be used as a venue for a variety of entertainment such as concerts, various types of events, and shows.

### ◎ An environment for Tokyo residents ease-of-use

The sub arena will be used for amateur sports promotion events such as district competitions and usage by college students, local residents, and people with impairments.

In consideration for the needs of users, gym and studio spaces will be provided, contributing to health improvement and sports movements among Tokyo residents.

### ◎ Opening event

An opening event will be held with the themes of “sports,” “music,” and “technology.” (August - September 2022)

\*Note: The details of this opening event will be announced as they are confirmed.

## Improved presence

- Utilising the latest cutting-edge IT technologies, the facility will aim to become a prominent smart arena in Asia.

### ◎ Cutting-edge communications environment

High-density Wi-Fi, 5G, and other cutting-edge communications technologies will be installed with the goal of creating an arena with high connectivity.

### ◎ Sports lessons utilising cutting-edge technology

Cutting-edge technologies will be utilised to create new value through activities such as sports viewing with cross reality (virtual reality (VR), augmented reality (AR), etc.) technologies.
