Contents of the report	Palm oil potentially used at the Tokyo 2020 Games were sourcing from more than 40 plantations in Indonesia, which were alleged to be developed without an operational permit.	
Process history*	[Date of reception to the end of December 2021] Tokyo 2020 considered processing this report. Due to the circumstance that the distribution route of palm oil is generally combined from many plantations, a long period of time is expected in order to confirm the relation between each alleged issue and more than 40 plantations mentioned in the report. In addition, Tokyo 2020 is a fixed-term entity which is closed after the Tokyo 2020 Games. Tokyo 2020 official website published that Grievance Mechanism Process is to be closed by end of 2021, and Tokyo 2020 may not be able to process the report depending on the time of its receipt and its contents. Tokyo 2020 staff were significantly reduced after the Tokyo 2020 Games finished. Due to these reasons, Tokyo 2020 considered that it is difficult to conduct the assessment with the process of the Grievance Mechanism. Tokyo 2020 informed this decision to the party reporting this report. Tokyo 2020 proposed to the party reporting this report to file these alleged issues with the local authority or tribunal, or to use the grievance mechanism of internal or external oil-related companies. With this, the process is closed.
